



ORDER OF THE EXECUTIVE

Re: Appointment of RCMP as Enforcement Officers

Enacted under the Enforcement Act section 3.1

YFNO 12/2016

BACKGROUND:

- A. On April 1, 2014, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (the “RCMP”) and Yuułu?ił?ath government entered into a Community Tripartite Agreement (the “Agreement”) for the use of the RCMP to provide First Nations Community Policing Services for Yuułu?ił?ath government;
- B. In accordance with section 9.1 of the Agreement, the RCMP has agreed to enforce Yuułu?ił?ath enactments; and
- C. Section 3.1 of the Enforcement Act authorizes the Executive, by Order, to appoint enforcement officers to enforce one or more Yuułu?ił?ath enactments and preserve and maintain public peace.

NOW THEREFORE THE EXECUTIVE ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) In this Order,
 - a) “RCMP” means the police service continued under the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Act (Canada);
 - b) “RCMP member” means any officer, regular member or special constable of the RCMP appointed under the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Act (Canada) and assigned under section 8.1 of the Agreement.
- 2) Effective as of the date of this Order and for so long as the Agreement and any renewals are in effect, each RCMP member is appointed as an enforcement officer under section 3.1 of the Enforcement Act to enforce all Yuułu?ił?ath enactments and preserve and maintain public peace on Yuułu?ił?ath lands.
