On Friday, September 13, 2024, the District of Ucluelet will be replacing the tsunami warning system in the Cedar Road parking lot. Following the replacement the system will be activated repeatedly throughout the day. During this time the warning message may not include the “test” messaging usually broadcasted during the routine Emergency Alert System tests.

In the event of a real emergency an alert will be sent out through text message, email, and a phone call through the District of Ucluelet Community Emergency Notification Service prior to the tsunami warning system activating. Subscribing to the Emergency Notification Service is the best and most reliable way to receive critical alerts, safety instructions and reliable sources of information during an emergency.
