The Cix^watin Centre will open as a warming centre on **Friday, November 22 from 8:00am to 6:00pm** for citizens to eat, recharge devices and warm up. Children <u>MUST</u> be supervised by an adult at all times. A light breakfast will be provided at 8:00am, lunch will be served at 12:00pm, and dinner will start at 4:30pm.

It has been arranged with the West Coast Motel for hitaċu residents to shower at their facilities for free starting on **Thursday, November 21** and continuing until power is restored in hitaċu. To access the facilities, tell the West Coast Motel staff that you live in hitaċu.

A Special Weather Statement has been issued by Environment Canada for another fall storm on **Friday**, **November 22** effecting the West Coast of Vancouver Island. The storm will not be as powerful as it was on Tuesday, November 19, but strong winds may down trees and branches, cause travel delays and slow down clean-up efforts.
