ʔuhʔaʕhasuu Citizens and Residents of hitaʕu,

A cold weather pattern causing temperatures to fall 5°C below normal ranges are expected to start **Friday, January 17** and continue to **Wednesday, January 22**. Temperatures will drop by 10 to 20°C late this week and over the weekend. Winds up to 70 to 100km/h are likely on **Friday, January 17** and **Saturday, January 18**, drastically enhancing windchill values. Mainly dry conditions are forecasted during this period of cold weather, though the risk of snow events increases for coastal communities starting next week.

Cold weather safety tips:

- Listen to the weather forecast by visiting weather.gc.ca/canada_e.html or use the WeatherCAN app.
- Plan ahead, stay dry, and dress warmly.
- Seek shelter when wind chill is significant.
- Keep active to stay warm.
- Be aware and check in with friends, family and neighbors, especially elders
